



PROCEDURE INFORMATION

EXPECTIONS OF OUR PATIENTS FOR PROCEDURES

- 1. Arrive **30 minutes prior to the scheduled procedure time**. Our practice has the right to reschedule you if you are late for a procedure, and you may be charged for an office visit.
- 2. You may eat and drink prior to the procedure, unless notified in advance by the physician or the discharge information.
- 3. You MUST have your driver with you during the entire office visit. Taxi cabs, buses, or other forms of patient pickup are not permitted.
- 4. List of conditions you must discuss with the physician if you have one of them:
 - Allergies to Latex, Contrast/Dye, Betadine, Shellfish, or Medications
 - Blood disorders that cause bleeding or clotting
 - Active cancer
 - Psychiatric disorder including PTSD, bipolar disorder, claustrophobia, or schizophrenia
 - Heart disorders on blood thinning medications
 - Diabetes or elevated blood sugar levels
 - Infections or cold
 - Poor experiences with prior injections

MEDICATIONS INFORMATION FOR PROCEDURES

- 1. Patients are required to bring a written/typed, up-to-date medical list with them to the procedure.
- 2. Medications listed below MAY need to be held prior to the procedure. Your physician will tell you when to hold this medication. NEVER stop a medication without notifying the physician. Tell your physician if you are taking ANY of the medications listed below.
 - Aspirin / Ecotrin / Alka-Seltzer (If greater than 81milligrams daily).
 - Ibuprofen / Advil / Motrin
 - Naproxen / Naprosyn / Aleve
 - Aggrenox
 - Coumadin / Warfarin
 - Lovenox / Enoxaparin
 - Heparin
 - Plavix
 - Pradaxa
 - Fish Oil / Krill Oil
